1. Primary colors.

- The basic colors that cannot be created by mixing other colors
- The building blocks for all other colors
- The three primary colors are red, yellow and blue

2. Secondary colors

- Colors created by mixing any two primary colors
- For example, mixing red and blue creates purple, red and yellow creates orange, and yellow and blue creates green
- Secondary colors appear between the two primary colors that created them

3. Tertiary colors

- Colors created by mixing a primary color with a secondary color
- Tertiary colors are broken colors, meaning they are less pure and chromatic
- Brown tones are an example of tertiary colors
