Creative Arts

Creative Activities/Creative Arts is a broad learning area consisting of three subject areas namely; Music, Art & Craft and Physical Education. These three areas support each other in their execution.

In performance of a song or a dance, the three components support each other in the following ways:

Music

- i. Music provides the songs and singing
- ii. Music also provides the skill of playing musical instruments
- iii. Music supports the overall performance through dance

Art

- i. Art skills are used in the making of the costumes used in a performance
- ii. Art skills of painting are used in body painting, adornment
- iii. Art skills are used to paint the musical instrument
- iv. The props and ornaments used in the performance are made using art skills
- v. The designing of formations and patterns requires the skill of art

Physical Education (PE)

- i. Non-locomotor and locomotor movements skills learnt in P.E are applied during a dance performance.
- ii. Warm-up activities gained in PE are applied as voice warm-ups before the singing and before a dance performance.
