Which are the different types of families in society?

- 1. Nuclear Family-Consists of parents and their children living together.
- 2. Extended Family- Includes parents, children, and other relatives such as grandparents, uncles, aunts, and cousins living together or maintaining close ties.
- 3. Single-Parent Family- A family where a single parent (either a mother or a father) raises the children due to divorce, separation, death, or choice.
- 4. Blended (Step) Family- Formed when two people with children from previous relationships marry or cohabit, creating a new family unit.
- 5. Childless Family- A couple who live together without children, either by choice or due to circumstances.
- 6. Grandparent-Headed Family. A family where grandparents take care of their grandchildren due to the absence of parents.
- 7. Foster or Adoptive Family- A family that raises children who are not biologically theirs through foster care or adoption.
- 8. Polygamous Family- A family where a person has multiple spouses, common in some cultures and religions.
